The Malawi School of Government (MSG), an entity created through an Act of Parliament No. 33 of 2022, amalgamated the former Malawi Institute of Management (MIM) and the Staff Development Institute (SDI). Its operations commenced on 1st December 2022 and now comprise two main campuses: MSG Kanengo (former MIM) and MSG Mpemba (former SDI).

Postgraduate Diploma in Monitoring and Evaluation (PD MEL)	Blended Weekend Approach	1 year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) A bachelor's degree in any field from an accredited programme and institution. b) Candidates with other professional qualifications but with relevant experience in Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability and Learning may also be considered.
Postgraduate Diploma in Public Service Management (PDPSM)	Blended Weekend Approach		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) A bachelor's degree in any field from an accredited programme and institution. b) Candidates with other professional qualifications but with relevant experience in the public service may also be considered.
Postgraduate Diploma in Finance for Non-Finance Managers (PDFNM)	Blended Weekend Approach	1 year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) A bachelor's degree in any fields from an accredited programme and institution. b) Candidates with other professional qualifications but with relevant professional experience in business may also be considered.
